

Archive sources citation guidelines in Contributions to Contemporary History

Archive sources should be listed in the footnotes as well as in the list of sources and literature:

- In the footnotes the following should be indicated: first the country code and established archive acronym, followed by the abbreviation denoting the archive collections, codes or numbers of binders or boxes, and numbers of archive units or names of documents as well as the date. In case that the archive acronym and the letters of the archive collection code are the same, the archive acronym may be omitted.
- In the list of sources and literature the archive sources should be listed separately from literature, newspaper sources, etc. First the shortened reference from the footnotes should be stated; then it should be written in its entirety. The following should be indicated: the country code and archive acronym, name of archive, archive collection code, name of archive collection, and any other specifications, if necessary. The titles of the documents are not to be indicated.
